Does your community use 911? Most places use a special number to call in all emergencies. If your area has a special number, tape it to your phone so it will always be handy. In a lot of places, this number is 911, but could be something different. If your area doesn't have a special number, the fastest way to get help in an emergency is to dial "0" and tell the operator what the problem is. Stay on the phone and don't hang up until the operator has gotten the person you need to talk to and you have been told what to do.
